
I hope to see a large turnout at this years upcoming Legislative Day. I look forward to seeing you there because you will already be someone who has made a difference.

were reconfirmed for the swap meet then we adjourned.



-Gary reported that Tampa is considering having "No refusal" DUI checkpoints. Where a policeman can pull you over and if you refuse the breath test, a judge on site, can issue a warrant for your arrest allowing the police to perform a mandatory blood test.

-In Virginia Beach, local police say it is not safe for young children to ride on the back of their parent's motorcycles and are proposing a state law that would ban it.

-North Carolina has new rules for motorcyclists. A list was included in our handout packet from Gary.

-PA repeats failing grade on Highway Safety – details in handout.

<u>Safety and Education</u> – Cecil has big news!!!! He and Dave met with Steven Schuler from Shelby County. On April 29th, at the Arlington Substation, all Shelby County mayors and police chiefs will be present to sign a proclamation declaring May as Motorcycle Awareness Month. They even want to put signs in schools and on official vehicles. There are only 2 cities left in Shelby County that have not adopted the Look Twice program. Shelby county leadership wants to be the first in TN to have all cities participating in the Look Twice program. There are only 4 towns left in Fayette County and we have 3 of 4 already in Tipton County. This is huge! Wheels of Thunder has purchased 1/3 of all the signs purchased in the state! 


